# Get on the floor

This collection of rugs inspired by gardens is perfect to complement your room of any aesthetic



THIS YEAR, NATURE inspired furniture and home décor stole the show as a major trend. Whether it was the colour palette with earthy tones, furniture inspired by natural forms, or motifs inspired by natural elements, there has been an effort to bring greenery inside the house. As the year concludes, Jaipur Rugs launches *Jardins du Monde*, inspired by Albert Kahn, a famous garden in Paris. It includes a magnificent variety of scenery, featuring a Japanese, an English, a French garden, forests and meadows. This variety reflects in the motifs of the

rugs collection.

Tatiana de Nicolay, the designer, says, the name *Jardins du Monde* resonates with her as it translates as 'gardens of the world' in English, and the collection has seven rugs that represent gardens from around the world.

Tatiana expresses that the most

interesting part of the collection is the unusual shape of rugs. "Jaipur Rugs gave me the full freedom and creative liberty, and that's how I decided to experiment on the shape and form of the rug itself. I was asked to design something I would want to have in my house, and that's how I came up with this."

She expresses that choosing the colour palette was a difficult process as she wanted to give it the feel of watercolours; while, curating the motifs was relatively the easier part as they are the elements found in nature itself. The most interesting part, she says, was going to the villages and witnessing the women artisans giving life to the design. The rugs, some hand tufted and some hand knotted, are made from premium wool, to exude the luxurious European look.

These pieces have a very subtle colour palette which makes it easy to style. While the large motifs can be a dominant statement piece in itself, it can also complement a room with any aesthetic. You can pair it with a heavy sofa of a contrast colour and surround the room with indoor or faux plants to give the perfect maximalist vibe. Drawing a contrast



to this, you can also pair it with a neutral-coloured sofa and complementing accessories to give the rug more significance.
