



## Jaipur Rugs × Princess Pea Unveil “DAYS” — A Poetic Tribute to Womanhood

India, November 2025 — Jaipur Rugs and multidisciplinary artist Princess Pea present “DAYS”, a capsule of hand-knotted carpets that transforms craft into a meditation on womanhood, identity, and the often-unseen labour of care.

Born from an art initiative with the Jaipur Rugs Foundation, **DAYS** evolved through intimate workshops between the artist and women artisans. The act of knotting became a shared language—slow, rhythmic, and reflective—turning each rug into a narrative of endurance and self-expression.

Inspired by the cyclical nature of menstruation, the collection uses colour and form to express phases of the body and spirit:

**Day 1 (Blue)** for depth, **Day 2 (Pink)** for tenderness, **Day 3 (Mustard)** for resilience, and **Day 4 (Salmon)** for renewal. Familial archetypes appear throughout the designs, reframing the home as a space of empathy and collective strength.

Translating Princess Pea's miniature artworks on silk into wool, the artisans' hands carry the emotion and intention of each brushstroke, transforming domestic labour into art.

“DAYS” captures the intersection of art, craft, and human emotion,” says Yogesh Chaudhary, Director, Jaipur Rugs. “It gives voice to women whose stories are often unheard.”

More than décor, DAYS is an invitation to pause and reflect — a quiet dialogue between body, material, and memory, one knot at a time.
